



## Legal Permissions Questions and Answers

- Q. May I make copies of the lesson materials found on the Small Group Support Site?
- A. Yes, you may make copies of any TEXT or GRAPHIC material you find on the Small Group Support Site for your personal use only. Group leaders may make copies of the material on the site for members of their group who do not have access to the Support Site.
- Q. May I make copies of the Temple and Compass found on the Small Group Support Site for myself or members of my small group?
- A. Yes, you may make copies of the artwork found in downloadable PDF format on our Small Group Support Site for your own use or to pass out to members of your group. If you wish to take these graphics to a copy center for professional printing, you will need written permission from Focus on the Family in order to do so.
